Preparations are underway for the showcasing of Aarogyadhoot, a Mobile Medical Unit, and the distribution of spectacles and nutrition bars, under the auspices of IndusInd Bank, Synergy India Foundation, Avis Hospitals, and Think Tankers Innovative Solutions Pvt Ltd in Hyderabad. This will be the first of 81 schools where the screening was done for new joiners and their intervention was done at the school itself as part of the School Health Screening and Monitoring in the presence of SRI HANUMANTH NAIK (Additional secretary TSWREIS), SRI CHANDRA SHEKAR VANAMALA (RANGAREDDY OSD TSWREIS). This initiative by Synergy India Foundation Hyderabad based NGO was driven by the immediate need to extend quality health care and ensure the ideal well-being of the younger generation after a medical screening conducted by IndusInd bank as a part of their CSR Initiative program revealed that a majority of students in the city are suffering from a wide range of abnormalities and ailments including anemia, underweight, defective vision, dental problems among others. In the school, the screening was done for 285 students out of which prescription spectacles were distributed to students which needed their vision to be corrected, nutrition bars for students with mild anemia, and a special diet was prescribed to students with moderate and severe anemia.
